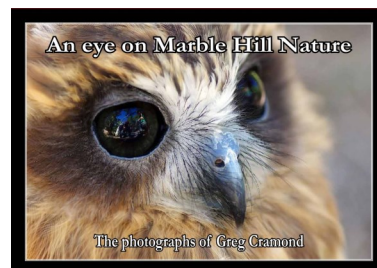

Get the family and neighbours involved in keeping our beautiful hills towns rubbish free. Join our teams supported by 4th Creek Landcare Group or start your own.

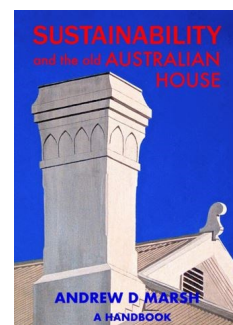


**SUSTAINABILITY FAIR @ URAIDLA** March 15th
